JUDGMENT

The claimant's application for reconsideration of the judgment sent to the parties on 7 November 2018 is refused.

REASONS

1. The claimant's claim was struck out for failing to comply with case management orders and for failing to pursue her claim actively. It appeared that she had not complied with the orders contained in the tribunal's letter dated 12 July 2018. The tribunal sent a strike-out warning letter on 19 September 2018, but the claimant did not reply. The judgment was sent to the parties on 7 November 2018.
2. By e-mail sent on 8 November 2018 the claimant stated,
"I have responded to the letters can some one please contact me regarding this?"
3. The tribunal responded with a letter dated 21 November 2018, stating:
"Employment Judge Horne has directed that the claimant's e-mail of 8 November 2018 is being treated as an application to reconsider the strike out judgment. By no later than 5 December 2018 the claimant must deliver to the Tribunal and the respondent's representative:

- 1) Any evidence on which she relies in support of her contention that she has replied to the tribunal's letters,
 - 2) Copies of any replies she has sent, and
 - 3) Details of any other grounds she has for reinstating the claim.
4. The claimant did not reply to that letter by 5 December 2018 and has not replied since.
 5. On a preliminary consideration of the reconsideration application it appears that there is no reasonable prospect that the strike-out judgment will be revoked or varied. The application is therefore dismissed.
