JUDGMENT

1. There was a relevant transfer from the 1st to the 2nd respondent on 16 December 2017.
2. The claimant's employment transferred from the 1st to the 2nd respondent on the 16 December 2017.
3. It is declared that there were unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages from 15 August 2017 to 3 January 2018 and the 2nd respondent is ordered to pay her the sum of £1,800 net.
4. It is ordered that the 2nd respondent pay the claimant the sum of £100 under section 24(2) Employment Rights Act 1996.
5. For the avoidance of any doubt the 2nd respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the total sum of £1,900.
