- 1. The Claimant's claims against the Respondent for notice pay and unpaid wages are dismissed.

- 3. The Respondent shall make payment to the Claimant in the sum of £108 as unpaid holiday pay on or before 6th February 2019.

 On or before 6th Febuary 2019 Gordon Dadds LLP shall pay to the Respondent the costs thrown away by the adjourned hearing on 18th May 2018 in the sum agreed of £249.50.
