## **JUDGMENT**

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The respondent did not discriminate against the claimant because of race.
- 2. The respondent did not discriminate against the claimant because of age.
- 3. The claimant is ordered to pay the respondent's costs assessed in the sum of £1,000.00 on the ground that:
  - 3.1 the claim had no reasonable prospect of success; and
  - 3.2 the complaint of direct race discrimination was vexatious.
