## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. Under section 23 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 the ordinary time limit for the Claimant's claim of unlawful deductions from wages expired on 30 July 2014.

- 3. Upon it becoming reasonably practicable for the Claimant to present his claim, he did not do so within such further period as was reasonable.
