(Upgrade of Footpath to Restricted Byway together with the Addition of Restricted Byways at Zelah in the Parish of St Allen) Modification Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The start date for the above Order is 6 February 2019.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at New County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro, Cornwall, TR1 3AY on Wednesday 31 July 2019 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

(i) Upgrading a length of existing Footpath Number 19 in the Parish of St Allen to be upgraded to Restricted Byway commencing at its junction with Classified Road C292 approximately 110 metres west-north-west of 'Cost is Lost' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SW 8033/5153 shown as point 'A' on the Order Map, then running in a generally south-easterly direction for a distance of 168 metres terminating at its junction with a Restricted Byway to be added by this order approximately 62 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8048/5145 shown as point 'B' on the attached Order map.

(ii) Adding a length of Restricted Byway in the Parish of St Allen commencing at existing Footpath Number 19 to be upgraded to Restricted Byway by this order approximately 62 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8048/5145 shown as point 'B' on the attached Order map then running in a generally south-easterly direction for a distance of 332 metres terminating at its junction with Classified Road C364, approximately 385 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8078/5130 shown as point 'C' on the attached Order map.

(iii) Adding a length of Restricted Byway in the Parish of St Allen commencing at its junction with Classified Road C364 approximately 402 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8080/5131 shown as point 'D' on the attached Order map then running in a generally southeasterly direction for a distance of 27 metres terminating at its junction with Bridleway Number 1 St Allen approximately 429 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8081/5129 shown as point 'E' on the attached Order map.

<u>Timetable for sending in statements of case and proofs of evidence</u>

Within 8 weeks of the start date by [by 3 April 2019]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 15 May 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

¹ If you wish to make a legal submission, this should be submitted at the same time as your statement of case. Otherwise legal submissions will have to be submitted in writing on the day of the inquiry.

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence);
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence); and
- iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority, the applicant, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence).

This Order is made by Cornwall Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the Act') because it appears to that authority that the definitive map and statement of public rights of way for the former Carrick District Council area require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(ii) of the Act, namely the discovery of evidence which shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description and Section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely the discovery of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant available evidence) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates.

The Cornwall Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 21 February 2017.
- The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the former Carrick District Council area shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.

A length of existing Footpath Number 19 in the Parish of St Allen to be upgraded to Restricted Byway commencing at its junction with Classified Road C292 approximately 110 metres west-north-west of 'Cost is Lost' at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SW 8033/5153 shown as point 'A' on the Order Map, then running in a generally south-easterly direction for a distance of 168 metres terminating at its junction with a Restricted Byway to be added by this order approximately 62 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8048/5145 shown as point 'B' on the attached Order map.

The length of Public Footpath to be upgraded to Restricted Byway is 168 metres. The width of the Bridleway described varies between 4 (four) metres and 10 (ten) metres, according to the depiction of the way on map sheets Cornwall XLVIII.11 from the Ordnance Survey County Series Second Edition published at 1:2500 scale.

Description of Path or Ways to be Added

A length of Restricted Byway in the Parish of St Allen commencing at existing Footpath Number 19 to be upgraded to Restricted Byway by this order approximately 62 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8048/5145 shown as point 'B' on the attached Order map then running in a generally south-easterly direction for a distance of 332 metres terminating at its junction with Classified Road C364, approximately 385 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8078/5130 shown as point 'C' on the attached Order map.

The length of Restricted Byway to be added to the Definitive Map is 332 metres. The width of the Restricted Byway described varies between 4 (four) metres and 10 (ten) metres, according to the depiction of the way on map sheet Cornwall XLVIII.11 and Cornwall XLVIII.15 from the Ordnance Survey County Series Second Edition published at 1:2500 scale.

A length of Restricted Byway in the Parish of St Allen commencing at its junction with Classified Road C364 approximately 402 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8080/5131 shown as point 'D' on the attached Order map then running in a generally south-easterly direction for a distance of 27 metres terminating at its junction with Bridleway Number 1 St Allen approximately 429 metres south-east of 'Cost is Lost' at OSGR SW 8081/5129 shown as point 'E' on the attached Order map.

The length of Restricted Byway to be added to the Definitive Map is 27 metres. The width of the Restricted Byway described varies between 4 (four) metres and 6 (six) metres, according to the depiction of the way on map sheet Cornwall XLVIII.11 and Cornwall XLVIII.15 from the Ordnance Survey County Series Second Edition published at 1:2500 scale.
