JUDGMENT

- 1 The claimant is entitled to damages for the respondent's failure to give notice of one month when he was dismissed in the sum of £3041.66 (gross).
- 2 The claimant is also entitled to one week's pay for holiday not taken in 2018 in the sum of £701.92 (gross). Deductions for tax and national insurance may be made and, if they are not, the claimant must account to HMRC for payments received.
- 3 The claimant's conduct in these proceedings has been unreasonable and he is ordered to pay the sum of £1800+£360 VAT (total £2160) towards the respondent's costs.
