JUDGMENT

The complaint raising allegations against the First Respondent for the period prior to 1 April 2013 is struck out.

REASONS

The Claimants were each ordered to pay a deposit of £500.00 in respect of each of two sets of allegations following a Preliminary Hearing held on 29 November 2018. An amended Deposit Order was sent to the Claimants on 25 January 2019. The deposits were then ordered to be paid not later than 7 days from that date. On 29 January 2019 the Claimants each paid a single deposit of £500. The Claimants have clarified at a Preliminary Hearing today, 4 February 2019, that the failure to send two separate deposits by each Claimant was deliberate. They intended to pursue all complaints against the Second Respondent but not the allegations against the First Respondent relating to the period prior to 1 April 2013. The Claimants have therefore failed to pay the deposits ordered in respect of those claims against the First Respondent. All of the complaints against the First Respondent for the period prior to 1 April 2013 are therefore struck out under rule 39(4) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013. The remaining complaints shall proceed to a final hearing and directions have been given separately to that effect.
