## **JUDGMENT**

Upon the Claimant having on 29 November 2018 applied for a reconsideration of the Judgment of 14 November 2018 and upon the Claimant also having made representations as to the preparation time order pursuant to paragraph 3 of the Judgment and upon considering the Respondent's reply dated 27 December 2018 the Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:

- 1. The reconsideration application is refused as there is no reasonable prospect of the Claimant being able to show that it is in the interests of justice that the Judgment be revoked or varied. The Claimant has given no adequate explanation for his failure to attend the hearing on 14 November 2018 and did not notify the Tribunal in advance of it (or even after it until prompted by the Judgment) to explain his absence. Further there is no reasonable prospect of the Claimant being able to explain his poor workmanship by the Ducati recall to which he referred to in his reconsideration application.
- The preparation time order stands for the same reasons. The Claimant's conduct of the proceedings was unreasonable, in particular by his failure to attend the hearing. The Claimant shall pay the sum of £330 to the Respondent within 14 days of the date that this is sent to the parties as set out below.
