The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is:-

- 1. The Claimant's complaint of sexual orientation discrimination is struck out because it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 2. The Claimant's complaint of disability discrimination is struck out because it has no reasonable prospect of success.
- 3. The Claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 4. The Claimant's complaint of race discrimination proceeds.
