Thank you for your email of 22nd January 2019 requesting the following information:

Under Freedom of Information legislation (FOI), I would like to know how many Grievances were received by DE&S HR in total regarding these calibration panel decisions, and how many of these have been upheld and how many have not been upheld. Also, how many have been upheld/not upheld for part-time working staff.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000.

As of 30th January 2019, we have opened 517 grievance cases relating directly to calibration outcomes and associated reward decisions.

Decisions have been made on 84 of these grievances, with two being upheld, four being partially upheld and 78 not being upheld.

None of the upheld or partially upheld grievances were from part time employees but, to date, there have been six grievances from part-time employees that have been heard and have not been upheld.

Under Section 16 of the FOI Act (advice and assistance), it is important to note that until all grievances have been resolved, it is likely that these figures will continue to change.
