JUDGMENT

- 3 The claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is well founded and succeeds.
- 4 The parties shall apply for a remedy hearing after twenty eight days if remedy is unresolved (providing dates of unavailability for a half day hearing in the period 3 September to 30 November 2018).
