### Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) Act 1995 ("the Act")

# <u>Decisions made in respect of the operator's licence held by Owen Evans (Haulage)</u> <u>Ltd OG0096114</u>

- 1. Adverse findings are made under sections 26(1)(c)(iii); 26(1)(e); and, 26 (1) (f) of the Act.
- 2. The operator continues to satisfy the requirement to be of good repute, section 13A(2) of the Act.
- 3. The operator continues to satisfy the requirement to have sufficient financial resources, section 13A(2) of the Act.
- 4. The operator continues to have the required professional competence, section 13A(2) of the Act.
- 5. All the existing non standard conditions and undertakings are removed and replaced with the following undertakings:
  - (1) PMIs will be no longer than 6 weekly;
- (2) rolling road brake tests will be carried out at least every other PMI, with the other test still showing a recorded test; and,

- (3) in addition to the existing transport manager, the operator will utilise an additional qualified transport manager for at least 10 hours a week.
- 6. The existing vehicle authorisation of 15 vehicles is curtailed to 12 vehicles until 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019.
- 7. The existing trailer authorisation of 6 trailers is increased to 12 trailers until 1<sup>st</sup> June 2019, at which time it is increased again to 15 trailers.

### **Decisions made in respect of Transport Manager Richard Neville Thomas**

8. Richard Neville Thomas retains his good repute as a transport manager albeit it is tarnished.

## <u>File notes (which can be copied to all present and is also for Licensing staff to note re a future increase in authorisation)</u>

- This is a business which is now regarded as good by the DVSA. Issues arose which have been addressed
- There is a connection revealed with a PI on 9 June 2018 involving Redstaff Ltd and Richard Francis and Edward Skinner who claimed a legitimate relationship with this operator. I refused their licence application and it is now clear that I was correct to do so. This operator was innocent and was duped, resulting in a letter being sent by this operator to Messrs Francis and Skinner. That letter has now been copied to the DVSA at my request.
