The Environment Agency is proposing to revoke (cancel) the abstraction licence numbers mentioned below.

The Environment Agency is required to give notice of this proposal. The Environment Agency give this notice under section 52 of the Water Resources Act 1991 and regulation 31 of the Water Resources (Abstraction and Impounding) Regulations 2006.

## **Details of the proposal**

Licence number 2569009135 allows the licence holder Stirling Lloyd Polychem Ltd, Union Bank, 127 King Street, Knutsford, Cheshire, WA16 6EF, to abstract a total of 70919 cubic metres (m<sup>3</sup>) a year at National Grid Reference (NGR) SK 0240 8696 at Mill Pond Fed By R Sett At Birch Vale, New Mills.

The proposal is to revoke (cancel) the licence listed above.
