

I am a funeral director in Chorley Lancs, with the price of crematoriums in Lancashire being between £690 and £770 it seems wrong that the Dignity crematorium in Chorley charges £999. This price is excessively more than all the others.

Saying the price of funerals has gone up above inflation, one of the main causes is the monies we pay out as "disbursements".

I try to keep prices low, my average charge is £1800 . But if I go much lower than this then people think I must not offer as good a service as the ones charging a lot more, so as an independent my prices are kept high because of firms like []. []. It definitely needs to be looked into.
