JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that the claims of age discrimination, less favourable treatment as a part-time employee, breach of contract by failing to pay notice pay and failure to provide a written statement of terms and conditions are well-founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the following sums:

1. Breach of contract by failing to pay notice pay £322.00.

2. Age discrimination and less favourable treatment as a part-time employee $\pounds 4,746.70$.

3. Failure to provide written statement of terms and conditions £1520.80.

4. This provides a total amount to be paid by the respondent to the claimant of $\pounds 6589.50$.
