## Order on application for reconsideration

The application dated 2 January 2019 for reconsideration of the Judgment of the employment tribunal sent out on 19 December 2018 is rejected as having no reasonable prospects of success pursuant to rule 72(1). The employment tribunal found that the stable working relationship ended on the 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2014 when the claimant's employment as an FSO ended and she then took up post as an OM on promotion. In paragraph 4 of the original judgment the employment tribunal set out its analysis of the relevant authorities, and identified that the appropriate test to decide whether there has been a termination of the SWR was whether there had been a fundamental or radical change in the work done in the employment .(See paragraph 4.6). In paragraph 5.2 we set out the specific reasons for our conclusion. I see no reason in the claimant's current application for overturning that conclusion.
