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JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL

The Judgment of the Tribunal, for the reasons given orally at the Hearing, is that the
25 claimant was unfairly dismissed by the respondent and the respondent shall pay to
the claimant a monetary award of Five Thousand, Eight Hundred and Eleven
Pounds and Ninety-Nine Pence (£5,811.99), by way of compensation; the
prescribed element is Four Thousand, Three Hundred and Twenty Pounds and
Eleven Pence (£4,320.11) and relates to the 39-week period from 16 April 2018 to
30 15 January 2019; the monetary award exceeds the prescribed element by One
Thousand, Four Hundred and Ninety-One Pounds and Eighty-Eight Pence
(£1,491.88).
