## JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds of non compliance with an Order of the Tribunal following a Preliminary Hearing on 8 January 2019 in terms of rule 37(1)(c) and that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

## **REASONS**

- On 12 February 2019 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 20 February 2019 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
