JUDGMENT

The Employment Judge gave judgment as follows:-

- 1. The Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear the claim.
- 2. The name of the Respondent is amended to AV UK Limited.

3. The Employment Judge granted leave to amend the claim so that the Claimant can pursue claims of breach of contract in respect of notice pay and holiday pay.

4. The Claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment in the sum of £6,384.00.

5. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent is ordered to pay damages to the Claimant in the sum of £1,832.00.

6. The Respondent has failed to pay the Claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of \pounds 1,489.60.
