JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant was not dismissed by the respondent because of her pregnancy, and her claim under section 39(7)(b) Equality Act 2010 fails.
- 2. The claimant was not treated unfavourably by the respondent because of her pregnancy and her claims under section 18 Equality Act 2010 therefore fail.
- 3. The above claims having been unsuccessful, the Tribunal makes no award to the claimant pursuant to section 38 Employment Act 2002, in respect of the respondent's failure to provide written particulars of employment.
- 4. All claims are dismissed.
