

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Cumbria County Council (Parish of Kendal: District of South Lakeland) Definitive Map Modification Order (No 3) 2017 proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following:

In the Order schedule

In **Part 1: Modification of the Definitive Map**

- Delete 'References on plan' "A-B-C-D-E" and substitute "E";
- Amend 'Description of length of right of way to be added' to: "A new 2m length of public footpath connecting Lumley Road Kendal with Stonecross Road at a gap in a wall at GR 350844 491186";
- Delete 'Width' as stated and substitute "1m";

In **Part 3: Modification of Definitive Statement**

- Amend 'Width' to "1m"; amend 'Length' to "2 metres"; and amend 'Description' to read "From Lumley Road to Stonecross Road";

On the Order map

- Amend the line of "Footpath to be added" to remove section A-B-C-D-E as shown.
