Thank you for your email of 14 January 2019 requesting the following information:

"Please may i request an up to date list of contractors, subcontractors and suppliers that have or will be involved with the 10-year framework to expand the Faslane and Coulport submarine bases on the Clyde in Scotland."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below:

The three contractors that have been appointed and will be engaged to manage the Work Packages through the Framework are:

- Kier Graham Defence Limited
- Morgan Sindall Limited
- VolkerStevin Limited

Names of any sub-contractors and suppliers is held by the contractors and not by the Department.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that as part of contract requirements, to gain a place on MODs framework, contractors do not have to declare names of subcontractors and suppliers, only that they would agree to operate within MOD policy in relation to governance and probity.
