Thank you for your email of 04 January 2019 requesting the following information:

"Under the freedom of information act, can you confirm if the MOD has sold any land adjacent to New Buildings Enford to Compton Farm Enford.

If so are there any restrictions in place regarding change of use from agricultural to industrial on any land sold, and the date of sale.

If there is no sale of land from the MOD to Compton Farm would there be any restrictions on tenant farmers for change of use."

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found enclosed below.

The MOD have not sold any parcels of land adjacent to new buildings at Enford. The MOD have only sold residential properties.

Any tenant farmer would need to gain permission for change of use from the Landlord and will need to comply with any other requirements such as planning.
