## **JUDGMENT**

The Claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is well founded and succeeds. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant as compensation for unfair dismissal a basic award of £3,040. The Claimant is not entitled to any compensatory award where, had a fair procedure been followed, his employment would have been fairly terminated in any event.

The Claimant's complaint in respect of unauthorised deductions from wages succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the further gross sum of £1320.75 from which deductions in respect of tax and National Insurance Contributions may fall to be made.
