SUPPLEMENTARY CERTIFICATION IN RESPECT OF SCHMALLEMBERG VIRUS (SBV)

I, the undersigned, further certify in respect of the semen described in certificate 8144EHC and numbered that:

* a) the semen was collected before 1 June 2011;

OR

* b) no cases of Schmallenberg disease were recorded at the artificial insemination centre at least thirty (30) days prior to semen collection and at least thirty (30) days after the final collection of the semen to be exported; AND

the donors of the semen to be exported tested negative to two serological tests recommended by the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE), the first carried out on a sample taken within thirty (30) days prior to the first collection of semen for export and the second carried out on a sample taken between twenty one (21) and sixty (60) days following the last collection of semen to be exported;

OR

* c) no cases of Schmallenberg disease were recorded at the artificial insemination centre at least thirty (30) days prior to semen collection and at least thirty (30) days after the final collection of the semen to be exported; AND

for donor animals that showed positive results to a serological test for SBV, or have an unknown SBV serological status, every batch of semen in this export consignment has been tested for the presence of SBV genome by an approved RNA-extraction method and RT-q Polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test, with negative results.
