JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The respondent's response in the claimant's case number 1807089/2017 is struck out pursuant to the warning of 13 July 2018 because the respondent failed to answer the tribunal's letter of 9 July 2018, failed to comply with the tribunal's case management orders and has failed to actively pursue its defence of the claimant's claims.
2. The respondent's contract claim in case number 1804935/2018 is struck out for the same reason. Had I not struck the respondent's claim out, I would have found that it failed, as no evidence was produced to support the claim.
3. The claimant's claims of breach of contract and failure to pay holiday pay succeed. The respondent shall pay the claimant £12,513.55 in respect of his successful claims.
