RepresentationFor the Claimant:The claimant represented himself.For the Respondent:The respondent did not attend and was notrepresented.

#### JUDGMENT

#### The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The respondent made unlawful deductions from the claimant's wages as set out below, which the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant on net basis, without deduction of tax:
  - a. in respect of his basic pay for the period from 1 to 30 July 2018, £1,551.25
  - b. in respect of his July 'tronc' payment, **£320**
  - c. in respect of unpaid wages for 1 to 7 August 2018, £431.83
  - d. in respect of 4 days, or 0.8 weeks' accrued but untaken holiday, £345.46
- 2. The respondent breached the claimant's employment by failing to give him

2 weeks' notice of termination of his employment. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant **£863.66**, without deduction of tax.

3. The total award (1 and 2) is therefore **£3,512.20** net, with no deduction for taxes.
