1. Minutes of the previous meeting and matters arising

1. Some minor adjustments to be made before publishing.

2. Feedback on recent stakeholder and comms activities

2. The secretariat expanded on the stakeholder update paper provided. A lot of meetings with prominent stakeholders this past month.
3. The chair commented that all the meetings with prominent stakeholders this month saw them welcome regulators coming into scope and none of them will welcome exclusions. They appear to be less concerned about whether it is in or out of scope but they want someone independent to add up the whole picture. They want to see the totality of the regulations that are impacting on business.
4. All non-qualifying measures will be seen by the RPC. The Chair's attention was drawn to regulators NQRPs reports but he believed they should have enough in for the RPC to quantify.
5. The chair agreed to further meetings with BRE over the rationale for NQRPs to ensure a joint front is presented and a clearer explanation is given. He also agreed to getting agreement over terms of reference as soon as possible and that the SoS meeting was an example of how having joined
