JUDGMENT

1. The unanimous decision of the tribunal is that:
 - 1.1 The claimant has not suffered discrimination arising from disability pursuant to s.15 of the Equality Act 2010.
 - 1.2 The claimant has suffered an unlawful deduction from wages on not being paid at the rate of a Saturday manager on working overtime on Saturdays.
2. On the parties having agreed the sum of the unlawful deduction the tribunal awards the claimant the sum of £3,268.43 gross from which Income Tax and National Insurance Tax are to be deducted.
