JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. The claim called for a Preliminary Hearing on 21 November 2017. The claimant did not attend. No explanation was provided to the Tribunal by the claimant for her non-attendance.

- By letter dated 29 November 2017 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 6 December 2017 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out.
- The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
