<u>JUDGMENT</u>

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. The claimant's culpable conduct prior to dismissal contributed to the respondent's decision to dismiss and the basic award is reduced by 80%, accordingly the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £630.00.
- 3. Had this respondent adopted a fair procedure the claimant would have been dismissed in any event on the 25th May 2018, accordingly the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant a compensatory award in the net sum of £857.50.
- 4. The claim for failure to pay accrued holiday pay is well founded and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the net sum of £343.00.
