The details given on this form are correct and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief and where required I agree to discharge the reasonable costs of the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in issuing the Export Health Certificate. I understand that:

- the certificate(s) will be provided on the basis of information available at the time and may not necessarily comply fully with the requirements of the importing country. It is the exporter's responsibility to check the certificate against any relevant import permit or any advice provided by the competent authority in the importing country. If these do not match, the exporter should contact the Centre for International Trade - Carlisle;
- in the event of suspicion or confirmation of disease after certification, it may be necessary for the Department to withdraw or cancel the health certificate without notice. No liability for losses incurred can be accepted by the Department should these circumstances arise;

- where certificates for OV signature are sent to the premises of dispatch or collected from Department Offices by any person other than the certifying Official Veterinarian, I undertake to ensure that the certificate will be held securely and delivered unopened to that OV;
- the information contained within this application may be disclosed to other competent veterinary authorities or used in the compilation of statistics.

Additional Declaration Statement by Exporter or Agent

I understand that:

- from 7 August 2014, the Russian Federation has banned certain commodities for the period of one year. That ban is ongoing and open ended. I understand that during this period of time these commodities:
 - are only allowed to transit through the territory of the Russian Federation via the specific border posts listed in 7730DEC; and
 - if moved to another Member State of the European Union for further processing, they may not necessarily be accepted into the Russian Federation;
- the Russian Federation does not accept consignments that transit through Belarus from 30 November 2014;
- the products described in this application must be consigned to:
 - either Belarus or Kazakhstan and I have received either an import permit from the Belarus or Kazakhstan authorities or a written confirmation from an importer in Belarus or Kazakhstan confirming that the consignment will be accepted;
 - a Member State of the European Union and, to the best of my knowledge at the time of dispatch, the consignment is intended for onward shipment with a final destination of Belarus or Kazakhstan only;
- the consignment will not transit through Belarus if destined for Kazakhstan via the Russian Federation;
- I accept that the consignment being applied for is sent at my own risk;
- I will be required to make a *declaration to the effect of the above additional declaratory statements and that making a false declaration is an offence and that I accept full responsibility if any problems arise with the export should there be any dispute relating to the matters being declared.
