JUDGMENT

The claimant's complaints of unpaid holiday pay on the termination of her employment and/or breach of contract and deductions from wages are dismissed pursuant to Rule 47.

REASONS

The claimant complained of unfair dismissal (the subject of an earlier Judgment) and unpaid holiday pay and a failure to make other payments (which were unclear). She was directed on 14 February 2019 to provide particulars of the sums claimed and reminded of that direction on 28 February 2019, when the notice of this hearing was also sent to her. She has neither provided the particulars nor attended today. Enquiries were made to her mobile telephone, to which there was no response with no facility to leave a message. The respondent's solicitor was also contacted, but could not assist, similarly having heard nothing from the claimant. In all these circumstances I have concluded that the claimant does not pursue her claims and it is therefore just to dismiss them on her failure to attend today.
