JUDGMENT

The judgment of the tribunal is that:

1. The claimant's claim for race discrimination contrary to the Equality Act 2010 was presented out of time. It was not just and equitable to extend the time. Therefore, the tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear the claim and it is dismissed.
2. The claimant's application to amend the claim form is refused and dismissed.
3. The claimant is not ordered to pay a deposit.
4. The dates fixed for the main hearing are cancelled.
