FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: ANNUAL FITNESS TEST

I refer to your e-mail dated 9 October 2018, which was acknowledged on the 10 October 2018.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

- “1. How many of your police officers (including special constables) and police community support officers (PCSOs) passed an annual fitness test in the past year?”**
- 2. How many of your police officers (including special constables) and police community support officers (PCSOs) failed an annual fitness test in the past year?”**
- 3. Based on the answers to Questions 1 & 2, what is your force’s pass rate, as a percentage?”**

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

- “1. How many of your police officers (including special constables) and police community support officers (PCSOs) passed an annual fitness test in the past year?”**

3. Based on the answers to Questions 1 & 2, what is your force's pass rate, as a percentage?"

98% of the officers that have taken a fitness test have reached the required standard.
