Cheshire East Council (Public Footpath No. 14 (Part), Parish of Bunbury) Public Path Diversion Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. Following an earlier exchange of written representations, the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which she proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections/representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order is 23 April 2019

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the Inspector's proposed modifications only.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert that length of Public Footpath No.14 in the Parish of Bunbury commencing at O.S. grid reference SJ 5630 5754 and running in a generally south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 70 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 5624 5750 then turning in a generally southerly direction for a distance of approximately 34 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 5624 5747 and its junction with Public Footpath No.15 Bunbury. To a new line, in the Parish of Bunbury, commencing at O.S. grid reference SJ 5630 5754 and running in a generally west south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 15 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 5629 5754 and then running in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 31 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 5630 5751 and then turning in a generally west south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 5625 5749 and then running in a generally south south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 27 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 5624 5747 and its junction with Public Footpath No.15 Bunbury.

The effect of the proposed modifications would be as follows:

- Within Part 2 of the Schedule, delete `15 metres to O.S. grid reference SJ 5629 5754 (point D on TCPA/031A) and then running in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 31 metres' and substitute `16 metres to point X on TCPA/031A and then running in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 27 metres'.
- Within Part 2 of the Schedule, delete the final three sentences and substitute: 'A total distance of approximately 120 metres in length. The footpath will be 2 metres wide between points A-X, 2.5 metres wide between points X-E-F and 4.5 metres wide between points F-C'.
- On the Order map, delete point D and insert point X.

and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.
