JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- (1) the Claimant's claim alleging unlawful discrimination because of something arising in consequence of her disability is dismissed;
- (2) the Claimant's claim alleging failure by the Respondent to comply with a duty to make reasonable adjustments is dismissed;
- (3) the Claimant's claim alleging unfair dismissal by reason of the Claimant's assertion of a statutory right is dismissed;
- (4) the Claimant's claim alleging unfair dismissal is dismissed;
- (5) the Claimant's claim alleging breach of contract is dismissed.
