REQUEST FOR INFORMATION - COPY OF THE "RED CARD" ISSUED TO MILITARY ON INTERACTION WITH JOURNALISTS

I can confirm that your request has been considered under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI(A)), and the process is now complete.

You asked for the following:

"Under the FOI Act, could you please provide a copy or details of the "Red Card" which was issued to British soldiers serving in Northern Ireland during Operation Banner and provided details on how soldiers interact with journalists. The specific period I am interested in is between 1989 and 1992."

I can confirm that, the card that you refer to is called "Public Relations Instructions" and "Press Awareness" which is green in colour. The only version that this office holds is dated 1990 and a photocopy of the card is attached at Annex A.
