FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: CRIMES COMMITTED DURING THE CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY PERIOD

I refer to your e-mail dated 30 November 2018, which was acknowledged on the 3 December 2018.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

“Under the Freedom of Information Act, please can I ask the following information on crimes committed during the Christmas holiday period in the past three years. Please can you tell me how many crimes were reported to your force in the two-week period from 20th December 2017 – 3rd January 2018? Could I have this information broken down by the type of crime (burglary, assault, sexual assault, etc), and by the eventual outcome (e.g. charged, unresolved)? Please could you provide the same information for the equivalent two-week periods in the two previous years (20th December 2016 – 3rd January 2017 and 20th December 2015 – 3rd January 2016)?”

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.
