- 1. The respondent has now conceded that the claimant is disabled within the meaning of section 6 of the Equality Act 2010 and therefore the only issue to be dealt with at this hearing is how far back the claimant can make his claims for disability discrimination.
- 2. In all the circumstances of this case I confirm that the claimant can only make claims relating to those issues from April 2017 through to February 2018.
- 3. Directions have already been made in this matter.
- 4. No further order or direction need be made.
