JUDGMENT ON REMEDY

The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £99.60 in respect of the unauthorised deduction of wages.

REASONS

- 1 There being no attendance by the claimant at the hearing on 21 May 2018, without any explanation or good reason, I am satisfied that the claimant knew about today's hearing as she has submitted a schedule of remedy pursuant to receiving the default judgment dated 29 March 2018.
- 2 The award for the unauthorised deduction of wages can be clearly ascertained from the schedule of remedy in the sum of £99.60 in respect of the underpayment of wages in July 2017 and December 2017.
- 3 The claimant has provided insufficient information about her entitlement to holiday pay and therefore no award has been made and this claim is subject to a separate order.
