JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d)

REASONS

1. The claimant failed to attend a preliminary hearing conducted by EJ MacLean on 21 September 2018 and was asked to provide a written explanation and confirmation that she was proceeding with her claim by 5 October 2018. None was received.
2. On the direction of EJ Whitcombe on 18 October 2018 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give written reasons by 25 October 2018 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out. No reply was received to that letter, nor to a chasing letter.
3. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
