Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Requests – 180829002

You asked for the following information from the Ministry of Justice (MoJ):

I would like you to supply me with information on successful claims and unsuccessful claims in the County Courts by Combined Parking Solutions, Combined Parking **Solutions Limited and Combined Parking Solutions Ltd**

Your request has been handled under the FOIA.

Because you have not specified a time period for your question I have assumed that it relates to the most recent financial year, 1 April 2017-31 March 2018.

I can confirm that the MoJ holds the information that you have requested and I have provided it below. The data is provided from 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018 inclusive. Whilst we have searched on all three company names listed above in our County Court case management and management information systems, we have only been able to bring back data for COMBINED PARKING SOLUTIONS LTD. This is presented below.

There were 46 claims issued by Combined Parking Solutions Ltd in financial year 2017/2018. Of those:

28 were judgments on paper in favour of the Claimant, in the absence of a defence and without a hearing.

The remaining 18 cases followed the routes below:

- 12 were lost (withdrawn, not pursued with, or paid)
- 6 had a defence filed and all of these were allocated to a track.

Of the 6 allocated to a track:

- 2 had a Judgement, both in favour of the Claimant.
- 4 were settled or withdrawn before the hearing.

Notes regarding the above data.

Data are taken from a live management information system and can change over time.

- Data are management information and are not subject to the same level of checks as official statistics
- The data provided is the most recent available and for that reason might differ slightly from any previously published information.
- Data has not been cross referenced with case files.
- The date parameter refers to the date of issue of the claim. The judgments listed here are subsequent judgments recorded on those cases.
- Some claims will be dismissed, withdrawn, or not pursued with or paid.
