JUDGMENT

- 1. The parties having reached agreement, the Claimant's claim for unpaid wages is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £873.04;
- 2. The parties having reached agreement, the Claimant's claim for unpaid and accrued annual leave is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £1,571.40;
- Following submissions and discussions with the parties, the Claimant's claim for notice pay under s.86 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is dismissed;
- 4. The Claimant's claim of failure to provide a statement of employment particulars is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £978.00;
- 5. The Claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is well founded as he was procedurally unfairly dismissed, but no award of compensation is ordered.
