## **JUDGMENT**

The Judgment of the tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment.
- 2. The respondent breached the claimant's contract of employment by failing to pay the claimant notice pay. The claimant's claim for damages for breach of contract succeeds.
- 3. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages.
- 4. The respondent did not give the claimant a written statement of particulars of employment.
- 5. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £5,540.48. The said sum comprises the following:
  - 5.1 a redundancy payment of £2,688.00
  - 5.2 a net sum of £1732.48 for failure to pay the claimant notice pay;
  - 5.3 a gross sum of £224.00 for failure to pay the claimant outstanding wages
  - 5.4 £896.00 which is 4 weeks gross wages for failure to provide the claimant with a statement of her employment particulars
