JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant's complaints of:-
 - (a) unfair dismissal;
 - (b) wrongful dismissal;
 - (c) direct race discrimination and
 - (d) unlawful deductions, all succeed.

2. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant compensation as follows:-

(a) Loss of statutory Rights -	£500.00
(b) Basic Award [$£330.65 \times 7$]	£2,746.17
(c) 7 weeks' notice pay	<u>£2,314.55</u>
(d) Compensatory Award – Loss of earnings to 17/04/19	£18,797.26
(e) Injury to feelings -	£25,000.00

- (g) The Respondent is ordered to pay interest on those sums at 8%, £2,915.36 in relation to the injury to feelings award from 1 November 2017 to 17 April 2019; and £1,476.30 in relation to all other heads, excluding the basic award and loss of statutory rights, from 25 July 2018 to 17 April 2019.
- (h) The Tribunal finds that the Respondent's conduct of these proceedings has been unreasonable, and the Respondent is ordered to make a contribution of £15,000 towards the Claimant's costs.
