Finally, can you confirm the whereabouts/fate of two airframes previously used for trials work by BAE Systems:

ZG773 (last seen on Horse Guards Parade during the RAF 100 celebrations) ZA411 (last noted in storage at Warton Airfield)"

We do not hold information in respect of the whereabouts of the front cockpit section of ZA360, which was scrapped in 2002, and I have not been able to establish the final status of the two airframes used by BAE Systems.
