I am writing to provide a substantive response to your recent request for information about M134 Miniguns which has been handled in accordance with the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000.

You originally asked:

I would like to find out as much as possible about Contracts issued to Dillion Aero Inc for the purchase and ongoing maintenance of the M134D Miniguns. Also, any reported problems with the Dillion M134D Miniguns.

Thank you for providing clarification on 12 April 2019; your request has been amended to:

I would like to find out about contracts issued to Dillion Aero Inc for the purchase and ongoing maintenance of the M134D Miniguns, to include overall contract details (value, length, start and end dates) and whether they are for the procurement or inservice support of miniguns. Also, any reported problems with the Dillion M134D Miniguns.

I can confirm that the MOD holds the information you have requested. Details of contracts awarded to Dillon Aero about the M134D Minigun are attached at Annex A.

For the second part of your request, about any reported problems with the Minigun, I wrote to you on 15 May 2019 to explain that it was necessary to consider whether this information should be withheld in accordance with qualified exemption Section 26 (Defence) of the FOI Act.

The Public Interest Test concluded that this information should be withheld. There is a public interest in enhancing the transparency and accountability of government by releasing information that demonstrates the MOD's commitment to openness and that it conducts business in an open and honest way. However, releasing technical reports about the M134D Minigun would provide an analysis of the availability and reliability of this force protection capability. This could allow known and potential adversaries to make considered plans that could prejudice the capability, effectiveness or security of the Armed Forces; potentially endangering military personnel.

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If you are not satisfied or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact us in the first instance at the address above. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
