## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant has suffered an unauthorized deduction from her wages and the respondent is ordered to pay her the sum of **£1500** for unpaid wages from 10 February to 16 March 2018 and **£11.67** for pension contribution for the months of December 2017 and January and February 2018.
2. The claimant was entitled to 5 days accrued holiday pay on termination of employment. The respondent did not pay the claimant and sum and is now ordered to pay the claimant the sum of **£300**.
3. The claimant's contractual right to notice was breached and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant damages in the sum of **£300**.
4. **All sums above are net.**
